- From 29 December 2020- today He is appointed President of the Port System Authority of the Eastern Ligurian Sea
- From 20 June to 30 June 2020 He is appointed Extraordinary Commissioner of the Port Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea
- From 8 August 2019 to 28 December 2020 He is appointed Secretary General for a second term of the Port System Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea.
- From 15 April 2015 to 9 April 2019 He held the position of Secretary General of the Port System Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea

He coordinated the preparation of the new security plans approved by the Committee for port Security including the "Cristopher Columbus Plan"; he oversaw the constitution, the organization and implementation of the activities of the company "Porti Levante Security s.r.l." for carrying out "in house" (d.m 154/2010) of port security activities. He takes care of the drafting of the Operational plan 2010/2012, performs the functions of chief of staff
- From 19 December 2006 to 31 December 2020 He is appointed Secretary General of the Port Authority of Bari: among the most important relevance during the mandate, he takes care of the expansion of the territorial district of the Port Authority to the ports of Barletta and Monopoli, preparing the related documents and the procedural innovations in the functioning of the Port Committee (Territorial Committees). He is responsible for the drafting of the 2007/2009 Three-Year Operational Plan. He prepares the reorganization of services of general interest to the passengers in the Port of Bari to overcome congestion problems and draws up a new Ordinance for the conduct of the harbour operations in the Ports of competence. He reorganizes the Operational Technical Secretariat and starts the process of the implementation of the Port Community System. He is responsible for the procedures of numerous tenders for the assignment of services and president of selection boards as well as for the selection of staff. He develops international cooperation activities and the activation of infrastructure and research project from EU funds.

- Aprile 2006 He was appointed Deputy Director of the periodical specialized in "New Port" marine harbour economy
- April 2006 He is designed by Puglia Region as an expert in the working group for the implementation of the Memorandum of understanding between the Region and RAM for the development of the Motorways of the Sea, in this regard context . He collaborates in the drafting of the related "Master Plan"
